Currently, English Storytelling is being conducted in 20 centres, while Hindi Storytelling is running in 30 centres. The Foundation is working to introduce both English and Hindi storytelling programmes in the remaining 45 centres, ensuring that every child benefits from engaging and interactive language learning.

Learning, Health & Hope Together



On 26 July 2026, Kishalay Foundation, in collaboration with Vrikshit Foundation, organized a meaningful programme at the Taltala Kishalay Edukids Centre, Sundarbans.

The initiative promoted personal hygiene, nutrition, and holistic child development through an interactive hygiene awareness session, distribution of hygiene kits, nutritious food, and sports materials. The programme began with the National Anthem, followed by confident performances by the children, including poems, rhymes, and English storytelling.

Learning Beyond the Classroom

Learning becomes truly meaningful when it extends beyond the classroom.

On 20 July 2026, Kishalay Edukids Center, Godkhali (Sundarbans), an initiative of Kishalay Foundation, organized a Market-Based Mathematics Learning Activity for its Class Two students.

Through this hands-on experience, students explored mathematical concepts such as counting money, understanding prices, addition, subtraction, and decision-making in a real marketplace setting. This experiential approach not only strengthened their mathematical skills but also enhanced their confidence and connected classroom learning with everyday life.



Ensuring Quality. Inspiring Excellence

Quality education begins with continuous guidance and monitoring

As part of its commitment to strengthening early childhood education, the Education Team of Kishalay Foundation, including the Quality Lead, HR, Health & Nutrition Lead, and Education Lead, conducted monitoring visits to seven Kishalay Edukids Centers.

The visits took place at Pathankhali (1 July), Sonakhali (3 July), Battali (8 July), Birajnagar (9 July), Shibganj (13 July), Alaberia (17 July), and Ranigarh (19 July).

During these visits, the team reviewed key aspects of classroom quality, child health and hygiene, soft skills development, nutrition, and overall learning practices. The initiative aimed to ensure high standards of education while fostering a safe, healthy, and engaging learning environment for every child.

Healthy Children. Stronger Kishalay. Promoting Hygiene and Health Monitoring Across Kishalay Edukids Centres

The health and well-being of children remain a key priority at Kishalay Foundation. Across all 52 Kishalay Edukids Centres, regular hygiene practices and BMI (Body Mass Index) assessments are being conducted to support children's healthy growth and development.

Through this initiative, children are encouraged to build good personal hygiene habits, follow healthy lifestyles, and understand the importance of maintaining their overall health. The Antis (teachers/caregivers) at each centre are actively ensuring proper hygiene practices and regular BMI monitoring.

Hygiene records and BMI reports from every centre help the team track children's health progress and provide necessary support whenever required.

As part of its commitment to children's holistic development, Kishalay Foundation organized a series of Physical Activity Sessions across three of its 45 Kishalay Edukids Centers, led by Sports Coordinators from the Kishalay Sports Academy.

The sessions were held on 1 July at Kamardanga Edukids Center (35 children), 9 July at Basanti Edukids Center (30 children), and 23 July at Taltala Edukids Center (45 children), with the active participation of teachers and caregivers.

Children enthusiastically took part in physical exercises, yoga, and fun-filled games designed to promote fitness, teamwork, confidence, and overall well-being. At the end of each session, nutritious refreshments were distributed to all participants.

Beautiful garments and decorative items—including Punjabis, sarees, frocks, bed sheets, and handkerchiefs—are being prepared through hand printing and stitching.

New dress samples for children have also been developed for the 2026 Durga Puja celebration.

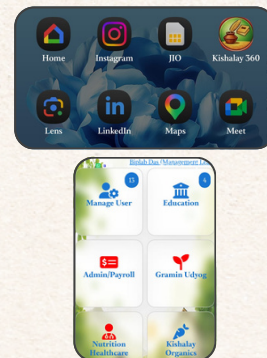

Kishalay 360 App is designed to support data-driven decision-making and enhance the overall management of education centres. Through this digital initiative, Kishalay Foundation aims to create a more connected, effective, and impactful learning environment for teachers and students alike.

The primary objective of this training programme is to enhance the leadership capabilities of Lead Teachers through Management Skills, Soft Skills, Quality Improvement Practices, and Lead Day Assessment. It aims to improve the quality of education and make the overall functioning of the centres more effective and impactful.

Among the 45 Kishalay Edukids Centres operated under Kishalay Foundation, 30 centres located in the Sundarbans region conduct regular monthly training and assessment programmes for Lead Teachers.
