#### Brightening Festive Season with Puja Clothes Distribution

This Durga Puja, Kishalay Foundation once again brought joy to hundreds of children by distributing festive clothes, ensuring that no child is left behind in the celebrations. On **October 2nd**, coinciding with Mahalaya and Gandhi Jayanti, we began this heartwarming initiative by distributing Puja clothes to **25 children in Godkhali village**. Their radiant smiles filled the day with hope and joy. The celebration continued on **October 7th**, as we extended the clothes distribution to children at our **centers across the Sundarbans and Murshidabad**. On **October 8th**, our efforts reached EduKids centers in **Ramgopalpur, Katakhali, Dulki, Shibgunj, Kalahazra, Basanti, Dhamakhali, and beyond**, making this cherished annual activity a beacon of community support during the festive season. Together, we celebrate the spirit of Durga Puja by spreading smiles and joy in the most meaningful way.

#### **Spectacles Distribution Camp**

On **October 4th**, Friday, Kishalay Foundation organized a Spectacles Distribution Camp at **Godkhali**, where we had the pleasure of providing spectacles to **40** local villagers. The event was an overwhelming success, bringing smiles to many people having a positive impact it had on their lives. This initiative is part of our ongoing efforts to improve the well-being and quality of life in the communities we serve.



## Sports, Yoga and Nutrition session

In November, Kishalay Foundation organized multiple initiatives promoting health, wellness, and nutrition programes across its EduKids centers. On 22nd November, a Yoga session followed by a nutrition program being conducted at our Godkhali EduKids center, where 40 children participated along with seven faculty members.

On October 15th, our Mahalong EduKids center in Murshidabad celebrated Saheli Madam's birthday with a special lunch for 31 students, along with a birthday cake. The children thoroughly enjoyed the festivities and the delicious meal.



Continuing the celebration, on 27th November, a nutrition program being organized at our Sonakhali EduKids center to celebrate Rahi's birthday. 72 students participated in the event, relishing a wholesome meal featuring vegetables, chicken, and payesh. The following day, on 28th November, we celebrated Adhiraj's birthday with a nutrition program at our Godkhali EduKids center, where 48 students gathered to enjoy a delicious lunch.



On 7th December, our Basanti and Shibgunj EduKids centers came together to celebrate Srihaan's birthday with a delightful meal of fried rice, chicken, and payesh. 21 students at Shibgunj and 27 students at Basanti, along with faculty members, participated in the celebration.



Continuing the celebration, our **Dorerdanga EduKids** center in Murshidabad honored Ishita Madam's birthday with a nutrition program attended by **39** students and two teachers. The children were overjoyed with the special meal.

#### **Haemoglobin Test Camp**



On **16th December**, Kishalay Foundation organized a **Haemoglobin test camp** for the mothers of our students at the **Satjelia EduKids center**. **20 guardians** attended the event, where we conducted tests and engaged in discussions on **Anaemia**, **nutrition**, and **hygiene**. The session aimed to raise awareness about the importance of maintaining good health and preventing anaemia through proper nutrition and hygiene practices.

#### Menstrual Hygiene Workshop

On 19th November, Kishalay Foundation conducted a menstrual hygiene workshop at Palpur Adarsha Vidyapith for adolescent school children. Around 70 students from classes 8 to 10 participated in the session, where they learned about menstrual health, hygiene practices, and the importance of breaking taboos

surrounding menstruation. The workshop aimed to empower young students with essential knowledge to promote better health and well-being.



#### **Cultural celebrations**



On October 8, 2024 on the occasion of Panchami the Satjelia EduKids center in the Gosaba block came alive with a vibrant cultural celebration. Students and faculty members gathered to showcase their talents through songs, dances, and performances, reflecting the festive spirit of the occasion.
